OUR MISSION

WEATHERVANE YOUNG ARTISTS' REPERTORY THEATRE seeks to inspire and challenge artists of all ages and backgrounds through theatrical performance, production, and educational opportunities to develop skills that will lead them to becoming more compassionate artists, community members, and leaders.

ABOUT US

Theater is one of the most disciplined art forms and, for us at Weathervane Playhouse, it is a calling, a developed craft, a debate platform, a profession, and a way of life. At WYART we offer a variety of performing arts classes and workshops, lead by professional artists and teachers, that emphasize technique, discipline, spontaneity, and theatrical skill.

The heart of the WYART programs is the process, not just the product. While many of our workshops culminate in performances or demonstrations, the focus during the programs is on the artistic and personal development of the individual student.

Along with the nervousness, excitement, fun, and passion that accompany being on stage, the Weathervane Young Artists' Repertory Theatre (WYART) is dedicated to providing young artists with a theatre education that will help them excel in the ever-changing performing arts profession, and beyond.

HISTORY

Weathervane Playhouse began holding performing arts classes, and offering on the job training for local youth of Licking Count in the mid 1980's.

Beginning with two-week theatre camps during the summer, and technical theatre apprenticeships for our Main Stage season. The program continued to grow each year, and in 2006 Weathervane Young Artists' Repertory Theatre was established to produce full scale professional grade productions devoted to the education of young artists.

Over the next decade WYART tripled it's offerings. WYART has been a partner for productions with C-TEC, has grown from one to six full productions, a now offers full core curriculum of classes and a large array of workshops.

WORKSHOP SERIES

WYART offers many different workshops on a rotating basis. These workshops allow for a snapshot of techniques beyond the basic core training of any performer or theatre professional. Often not part of the regular term, Workshop opportunities may appear when you least expect them!

- **Stage Combat Workshop** 12+
An intensive study on how to safely execute stage hand to hand, or weapons based combat through safe practices.
- **Audition Workshop : Age ranges may vary.**
A short study on techniques used in typical auditions. This workshop may help prepare students for upcoming auditions, or improve their general audition technique. Workshops may be aimed at specific types of auditions: Musical Theatre, Shakespeare, Commercial etc.
- **BACKSTAGE Workshop** Ages 12 & up
This workshop style class will focus on producing the technical elements used in productions. Technical elements of theatrical productions are: costumes, props, lighting, sound, carpentry, Scenic painting, stage management, directing, administration. This workshop helps prepare students for applications into our Summer Apprenticeship Program.
- **Improv** *Ages 10+*
“Saturday Night Live” meets "Who's Line is it Anyway" in this fun and inventive class. Students will produce their own works through a combination of writing and improvisation games.
- **Puppetry**
This Workshop will focus on the Art of Puppetry, and may even be used to workshop for puppets to be used in productions for Weathervane’s Mainstage Productions.
- **Stage Make-up**
The art of aging yourself, using latex prosthetics, or even growing a beard! are explored in this workshop .
- **Master Classes**
This Workshop Series will give students and opportunity to expand their knowledge by working with guest instructors from the professional Theatre Community who have been recognized in their field. Topics for this series of Workshops will be varied and dependant on the guest instructor’s area of expertise.

SPRING WORKSHOPS

APRIL 3 - MAY 29

PUPPETRY WORKSHOP: SATURDAYS 10AM-2PM MAY 6-27

Students will create full scale and small puppets during the course of this workshop. Students will learn crafting techniques as well as puppet performance techniques. The Puppets may be chosen to be featured in Weathervane's production of *Children of Eden*!

STAGE COMBAT 1: HAND TO HAND COMBAT APRIL 5-26, WEDNESDAYS 5-8PM

An intensive study on how to safely execute stage hand to hand combat; Taught by a Certified SAFD fight Director Jason Speicher. Students will learn safe fighting techniques, basic footwork, spacial awareness, how to pass and basic punches, slaps, blocks, shoves and grabs. This class will present their work at the end of their workshop to invited guests.

STAGE COMBAT 2: SWORD FIGHTING & SWASH BUCKLING

WEDNESDAYS 5-8PM MAY 3-24,

An intensive study on how to safely execute combat with weapons! Taught by a Certified SAFD fight Director Jason Speicher. Students will learn safe fighting techniques, basic footwork, spacial awareness, how to pass and basic slashes, blocks and choreography. This class will present their work at the end of their workshop to invited guests. Students must have taken Stage Combat 1 to be eligible.

BACKSTAGE WORKSHOP: AGES 12+ 4WKS THURSDAYS, 6-8PM APRIL 6-27/ MAY 4-25

This workshop style class will focus on producing the technical elements used in productions. Technical elements of theatrical productions are: costumes, props, lighting, sound, carpentry, stage management, directing, administration. This workshop helps prepare students for applications into our Summer Apprenticeship Program.

WYART SUMMER REPERTORY SERIES

WYART Summer Repertory Series produces three full scale productions. Each production is aimed at specific age groups and experience levels in order to give students more of a chance to shine and develop their skills.

When students are not directly rehearsing on the show, they will work with instructors on developing technical skills, as well as designing costumes, sets, and props for the show.

WEATHERVANE PLAYHOUSE APPRENTICESHIPS

Weathervane Playhouse has a tradition in training young artists in the areas of backstage or technical theatre. This training is a hands-on experience with growing professionals in the business. This tradition has become known as the Weathervane Playhouse Apprentice Program.

The apprentice program is an unpaid educational adventure that is an invaluable experience in learning the business of theatre, the mechanics of putting on a production, honing and learning new skills and observing professionals in their craft. A fully hands-on learning experience, that is cultivated in real-job application. Many of our apprentices have gone on to have very successful careers in theatre, film and other areas.

We offer 3 different Apprenticeship programs during the course of the year: Fall, Winter & Summer. Our Fall and Winter apprenticeships are a smaller group of selected students. Our Summer group is a large competitive selection from students all over the area who assist us with our Summer Season of 5 productions in just 12 weeks.

Weathervane Apprentices are encouraged to participate in tech week, and strike. Among the benefits of our Apprentice program are 2 complimentary tickets to the productions the student is working on, and a credit or discount for a WYART class.

You must be 14 years of age or older to apply.

TUITION AND REFUND POLICY

The Tuition and Refund Policy outlined here applies to all WYART classes, Productions and Workshops.

TUITION

One-half of tuition fees are due at the time of registration for classes related to a WYART Production or WYART Workshop. The remainder of tuition fees are due prior to the start of the first class, or on the day of the first class prior to the beginning of said class.

Failure to pay the remaining amount of tuition prior to the start of the first class will result in cancellation of registration for the Production or Workshop, and refund or credit processing based on timing as outlined below.

REFUNDS OR CREDITS

Requests for tuition refund due to withdrawal from classes related to WYART Productions or WYART Workshops will only be accepted under the following circumstances:

- Withdrawal at least 7 days prior to the start of the first day of class will result in a full refund or credit of the total amount paid by the registrant.
- Withdrawal during the week prior to the start of the first day of class will result in a 90% refund or credit of the total amount paid by the registrant.
- Withdrawal occurring on, during, or after the first day of class and prior to the start of the second day of class will result in a refund or credit of 75% of the total amount paid by the registrant. Weathervane Playhouse will retain 25% of the paid amount as a service fee for cancellation.
- Withdrawal after the second day of class and prior to the start of the third day of class will result in a refund or credit of 25% of the total amount paid by the registrant. Weathervane Playhouse will retain 75% of the paid amount as a service fee for cancellation.
- Withdrawal after the third day of class will result in no refund or credit of the total amount paid by the registrant.

During a WYART session, if a discount is offered within a specified date range and the discount code is not used upon initial sale of tuition, the registrant will not be eligible for a refund for the difference between full tuition and discounted tuition.

During a WYART session, a package of two or more classes may be offered where those classes are sold at a discounted rate within the package. If a registrant purchases two or more classes and the package is not selected at time of initial purchase, the registrant will not be eligible for a refund for the difference between classes and package.

If a class or production workshop is cancelled for any reason by Weathervane Playhouse, registrant will receive a full tuition refund or credit of the total amount paid.
